Keynote Speaker - Vincent Tinto

In his keynote address, Taking Student Learning Seriously, Professor Tinto will describe the programs colleges and institutes now successfully employ to more fully engage students in learning. He will also lead a discussion covering issues of learning communities and assessment for program improvement.

With a PhD in education and sociology from the University of Chicago, Professor Tinto is currently Distinguished Professor at Syracuse University and Chair of the Higher Education Program. He has researched and consulted widely with federal and state agencies, independent research firms, foundations and two- and four-year institutions of higher education on a broad range of higher educational issues, with an extensive focus on student retention and the impact of learning communities on student growth and attainment. His current research focuses on the impact of learning communities on the academic achievements of under-prepared students in urban two- and four-year colleges.
